### Needed:

- 50 bags (old fashion brown lunch bags work great)
- SaraBibikDance PDF English Meanings
- SaraBibikDance PDF French Ballet Terms
  - Each PDF of the French Ballet Terms has 50 terms written twice.
    - Suggestion; give each dancer 15-20 French Ballet Terms.
    - The following formula is for 20 words each dancer.
      - up to 5 dancers = one print out of the French Ballet Terms PDF
      - 6-10 dancers = two copies of the French Ballet Terms PDF
      - 11-15 dancers = three copies of the French Ballet Terms PDF
      - 16-20 dancers = four copies of the French Ballet Terms PDF
- Glue or tape
- Space for 50 bags options:
  - Using painters tape, you can tape the bags to the wall OR
  - Using tables, stools, or shelves, you can stand bags on their own.
- Optional: A ballet dictionary or two.

## Ballet Bag Drop TERMS ADV FRENCH TERMS

There are 50 French Ballet Terms for Adv Ballet Bag Drop. Each one is written twice.  
*Suggestion; give each dancer 15-20 French Ballet Terms.*

The following formula determines how many copies to print to get 20 words per da:

- ➔ up to 5 dancers = one copy
- ➔ 6-10 dancers = two copies
- ➔ 11-15 dancers = three copies
- ➔ 16 to 20 dancers = four copies
